



Pedal Kart Safety Rules

To ensure the safety of everyone using the hire equipment the following safety rules, as well as those in Jump Easy's Safety Pack, must be followed at all times:

- A **responsible adult** (18 years and over) must **supervise** the riders at all times
- Do not operate if winds exceed 40km/hr, in heavy rain, during a storm, or on wet surfaces- please refer to emergency procedure below and in the Safety Pack
- No riders with current or pre-existing injuries, or physical or mental impairments. No riders under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication permitted.
- Do not operate on a slope in any instance. Operate on flat even surfaces only. Do not operate near any hard objects or anything that could pose a hazard.
- Riders under 5 years of age must be under direct supervision of an adult. This is the same for riders who are not confident in pedaling, steering and stopping
- Keep 1m away from walls and any other hard object if not riding in the track.
- **Karts should be checked in between each use for any loose parts/ bolts and ensure they are functioning correctly: steering, breaks, pedaling, seat pins and tyres inflated**
- **Riders are to wear closed in shoes and helmets at all times.** Be aware of loose shoe laces or clothing that may get tangled or be hazardous near the pedals
- Maximum rider weight: 50kg for medium size karts, 80kg for large karts (pink and blue)
- Ensure seats are clipped into place correctly with safety pin (under the seat) and the rider is correct size for the kart
- **If not using the inflated track a designated area is required:** marked out with cones or lines away from any potential hazards. Riders must only ride within this area
- Riders should keep a minimum 1m distance from each other to avoid collisions.
- **Pedal to go forwards, push pedals back to break, pedal backward for reverse.**
- Do not ride within 5m of roads, footpaths, public spaces, or anywhere that may present a hazard to riders.
- **Do not allow riders to pedal backwards then forwards** (reverse to first) as this can make the kart do wheelies which is unsafe.
- Instruct riders to **slow down when cornering** (to avoid tipping over) and when riding around other riders, especially if around younger children or inexperienced riders.

Covid safety- Please adhere to current recommendations from SA Health and/or the Department of Education SA that may be applicable to this hire situation.

EMERGENCY- In the event of emergency such as adverse weather please disconnect power to track and/or take karts indoors or to a safe area and ensure riders assemble at a safe place.
